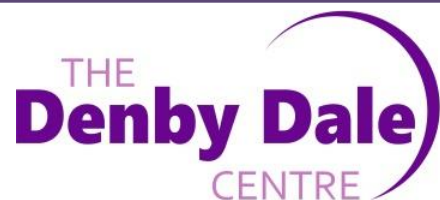

- Computer Training, Dementia Days, Film Club, End of Life Group, Coffee Morning, Tea Dance, Drop In, Cream Teas
- Ring and Ride shopping/excursions, Group Transport, Accessible Transport
- Community Centre, Youth Club, Toddler Group, Diet Group, Dance Fitness Group, Friendship Group, Choir
- Drop In Centre, Community Info Hub, Shop, Prayer group, Reading Group, Writing group
- Drivers, Activity Assistants, Cooks, Shop Assistants, Photographers, Micro-volunteering and others
